

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant

RES. NO. 121-83

1 WHEREAS, block grant appropriations has been proposed for FY 1984 for
2 several federal programs including the Health and Human Services/
3 Office of Family Assistance, Low Income Home Energy Assistance
4 Program; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has previously applied for and received funding
5 from the Health and Human Services/Office of Family Assistance; and

6 WHEREAS, Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant is available directly
7 to Indian Tribes meeting certain eligibility requirements; and

7 WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Papago Tribe to apply for an FY 1984
8 Low Income Energy Assistance grant; and


8 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe believes that it will satisfy the eligibility
9 criteria set forth in the funding regulations.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize
11 the officials of the Papago Tribe to submit a request for block
12 grant funding from the Health and Human Services/Office of Family
13 Assistance.


13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
14 Chairman, or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are
15 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary documents
16 to request FY 1984 funding for Low Income Home Energy Assistance
17 block grant.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th
18 day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
21 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
22 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
23 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
25 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
26 its enactment by the Papago Council.
