Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant

WHEREAS, block grant appropriations has been proposed for FY 1984 for
several federal programs including the Health and Human Services/
Office of Family Assistance, Low Income Home Energy Assistance
Program; and WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has previously applied for and received funding
from the Health and Human Services/Office of Family Assistance; and
WHEREAS, Low Income Home Energy Assistance Block Grant is available directly
to Indian Tribes meeting certain eligibility requirements; and
WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Papago Tribe to apply for an FY 1984
Low Income Energy Assistance grant; and
WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe believes that it will satisfy the eligibility
criteria set forth in the funding regulations.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize the officials of the Papago Tribe to submit a request for block
grant funding from the Health and Human Services/Office of Family
Assistance.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
Chairman, or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are
hereby authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary documents
to request FY 1984 funding for Low Income Home Energy Assistance block grant.
The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th
day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
(d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12,1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
