

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Revenue Sharing/Allocation to Districts '83

RES. NO. 122-83

1 WHEREAS, the Office of Revenue Sharing has allocated \$226,264.00 as
2 Entitlement #14 for use in accordance with the requirements of
3 the Revenue Sharing program; and
4 WHEREAS, the regulations require that public hearings be held to receive
5 testimony and comments regarding the use of the revenue sharing
6 entitlement; and
7 WHEREAS, the Revenue Sharing office has held the required public hearings
8 and the Tribal Council has determined as a result thereof, that
9 the entitlement funds can best be used by equally distributing
10 \$15,063.81 to each of the 11 Districts.
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve
12 the equal distribution of Entitlement #14, \$226,264.00, to be
13 distributed to each of the 11 Districts in allotments of \$15,063.81
14 each.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
16 day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 700.0 for; 476.0 against; 264.0 not voting; and 3 absent,
18 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and
19 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
20 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
21 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
22 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
23 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the
24 Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
