


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Revenue Sharing/Administrative Service Costs

RES. NO. 123-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 122-83, approve the
2 equal distribution of Entitlement #14, \$226,264.00, to each of
3 the 11 Districts in allotments of \$15,063.81; and
4 WHEREAS, there is a balance of \$60,562.00 proposed for use in administering
5 the Revenue Sharing program; and
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the proposed use of the \$60,562.00
7 and finds it to be in the interests of the Papago Tribe and the
8 Revenue Sharing office and approves the same.
9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve
10 the budgeting of \$60,562.00 for use in administering the purposes
11 of the Revenue Sharing office.


12 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
13 day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
14 of 592.0 for; 460.0 against; 388.0 not voting; and 3 absent,
15 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and
16 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
17 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
18 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
19 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
20 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the
21 Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


