

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Water Management Plan

RES. NO. 124-83

1 WHEREAS, on October 12, 1982, Title III of Public Law 97-293 (96 Stat. 1275)  
2 Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982 was enacted  
3 into law; and

4 WHEREAS, the law provided for the establishment of a water management plan  
5 for groundwater pumped from beneath the San Xavier Reservation and  
6 that portion of the Schuk Toak District that lies within the Tucson  
7 Active Management Area and that part of the Upper Santa Cruz Basin  
8 not within said area (eastern portions of the Garcia Strip and  
9 Vaya Strip); and

10 WHEREAS, the fiscal year 1983 Supplemental Appropriation Bill now pending  
11 before Congress which could soon be enacted into law contains the  
12 sum of \$50,000.00 for the establishment of this Water Management  
13 Plan; and

14 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe, the San Xavier District and the Schuk Toak District  
15 should be involved in the development of this Water Management  
16 Plan; and

17 WHEREAS, the Act provides that the functions of the Bureau of Reclamation  
18 shall be subject to the provisions of the Indian Self-Determination  
19 and Education Assistance Act (88 Stat. 2203; 25 U.S.C. 450) to the  
20 same extent as if performed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

21 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation has never in the past been subject to the  
22 Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act and does not  
23 have the mechanism or procedures to enter into a P. L. 95-638  
24 Contract with the Papago Tribe within the necessary time limit  
25 (fiscal year 1983); and

26 WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Papago Tribe if the Bureau  
27 of Indian Affairs became the lead Agency for the development of the  
28 Water Management Plan so that the Papago Tribe could timely enter  
29 into a P. L. 95-638 Contract to participate in the development of  
30 this Water Management Plan.


31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby  
32 request that the Bureau of Indian Affairs be designated as the lead  
Agency for the development of the Water Management Plan mandated in  
Public Law 97-293 (96 Stat. 1275).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer and  
Legal Counsel take all steps necessary to expedite the purpose of  
this Resolution including preparation for entering into a P. L. 95-  
638 Contract within the time restriction required by law for the  
utilization of the \$50,000.00 included in the 1983 Supplemental  
Appropriation designated for the development of this Water Manage-  
ment Plan.


The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of

1 1211.0 for; 114.5 against; 114.5 not voting; and 3 absent,  
2 pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (m)  
3 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
4 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
5 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
6 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
7 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
8 its enactment by the Papago Council.
