

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Thohono O'otham Youth

RES. NO. 125-83

1 WHEREAS, in 1981, Papago people interested in the welfare and development of
2 the young people residing on the Papago Reservation organized a
3 Youth Conference to be held on the reservation each year; and
4 WHEREAS, the main purpose and goals of the Youth Conference is to promote
5 and encourage Papago young people in the fields of education,
6 social and cultural experiences and to provide youth counseling
7 and recreation; and
8 WHEREAS, the organizers of the Youth Conference and its concepts, purposes
9 and goals are volunteer parents and adults interested in the
10 welfare and responsible growth of young Papago children; and
11 WHEREAS, today there exists a continuing committee of 15-20 of parents and
12 adults who volunteer their services in organizing and running this
13 youth conference, acquiring donations and/or financing needed to
14 continue this program and reporting its activities and progress
15 to the District Councils and interested District parents and
16 groups; and
17 WHEREAS, the youth conference, the organizers and Papago young people need
18 the support and encouragement of the Papago Tribal Council so that
19 purposes and goals of this organization can be successful; and
20 WHEREAS, the organizers and workers have a critical need for a small office
21 as a permanent headquarters for the youth conference organization
22 and other youth related services.
23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby
24 give its full support for the purpose and goals of the youth
25 conference and other youth related services and its organizers,
26 and instructs the Chairman or his designee to seek an office
27 suitable for its purposes.
28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council applauds the dedicated efforts
29 and work of this volunteer organization and is willing to work for
30 the leaders of this organization to gain the necessary financial
31 support for the continuance and expansion of the benefits of this
32 organization.
33 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (h), (l)
and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
