


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Contracting of Mineral Inventory Program


RES. NO. 126-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has determined that a Mineral Inventory  
2 Program is needed on the Papago Reservation; and  
3 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council authorized the Mineral Inventory Program  
4 by Resolution No. 52-75, to be funded by the Bureau of Indian  
5 Affairs and Administered by the U. S. Geological Survey and the  
6 U. S. Bureau of Mines; and  
7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council passed Resolution No. 109-80 to continue the  
8 Mineral Inventory Program in 1980; and  
9 WHEREAS, P. L. 93-638 25 CFR, Part 271, has provided the Tribe with the  
10 mechanism to contract Bureau operated programs.  
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby  
12 authorize the Papago Tribe to enter into a 1 year contract with  
13 the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to 25 CFR 271.12 and 271.14  
14 for the Mineral Inventory Program, the contract period beginning  
15 October 01, 1983, through September 30, 1984.  
16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs provide the Papago  
17 Tribe with any and all technical assistance necessary in the  
18 preparation of the contract.  
19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Treasurer of  
20 the Papago Tribe are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute  
21 the contract and any amendments thereto on behalf of the Papago  
22 Tribe.  
23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
24 day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
25 of 1071.5 for; 316.0 against; 52.5 not voting; and 3 absent,  
26 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (e)  
27 and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
28 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
29 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
30 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
31 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
32 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
