

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Table New Budgets until Reviewed by Districts
with Exception of Five (5)



1 WHEREAS, the new fiscal year for 1984 will begin October 1, 1983; and
2 WHEREAS, all tribal department and program directors have prepared
3 proposed FY '84 budgets; and
4 WHEREAS, the Executive Office and the Budget & Finance Committee have
5 reviewed the proposed budgets and recommended their approval; and
6 WHEREAS, the Executive Office has recommended 11 new programs to be
7 funded and operated with Tribal revenues; and
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that review and comment should be
9 made by all interested tribal members on all new proposed
10 programs to be funded out of tribal revenues except the following
11 programs: Elderly, Water Lobby, Early Childhood, Property
12 & Supply and Health Staff (2).


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that no decision or action be taken on the
14 new proposed programs to be funded out of tribal revenues and
15 that the new proposed programs be taken back to the Districts
16 for review and comment by all interested tribal members, with
17 the exception of the following: Elderly, Water Lobby, Early
18 Childhood, Property & Supply and Health Staff (2).

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
20 day of September, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
21 vote of 640.0 for; 487.0 against; 313.0 not voting; and 0
22 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2
23 (h) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe
of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
