

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Participation in the Selection
of B.I.A. Superintendent

RES. NO. 154-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised that in December, 1983, Mr.
2 Curtis Nordwall will retire from his duties as Superintendent
3 of the Papago Agency; and
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has the authority pursuant to Article V,
5 Section 3 (f) to make recommendations to the Assistant Secretary
6 for Indian Affairs concerning the appointment and removal of
7 employees assigned to duties on the Papago Reservations; and
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes it is in the best interest of the
9 Papago Tribe to participate in the selection of a new
10 superintendent.
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby affirm
12 its right to make recommendations to the Assistant Secretary of
13 Indian Affairs concerning the appointment and removal of Bureau
14 employees and does hereby express its desire to actively parti-
15 cipate in the selection of a new superintendent upon the retire-
16 ment of Mr. Curtis C. Nordwall.
17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby direct Josiah
18 Moore, Chairman of the Papago Council to take the necessary
19 steps to carry out the intent of this resolution.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 16th
21 day of September, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
22 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (m) and
24 Section 3 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe
25 of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
26 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
27 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
28 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
29 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
