

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Funding Approval for Two Weeks for Programs from Tribal Funds



1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is presently operating the Adult and Children's  
2 Court under funds contracted from the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and  
3 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has requested the Bureau of Indian Affairs to  
4 contract with the Papago Tribe under P. L. 93-638 regulations and  
5 procedures for the operation of the Social Services program; and  
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has learned that the Area Office will not have  
7 the above listed contracts ready for signature by October 1,  
8 1983; and  
9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has consistently refused to fund or operate  
10 programs funded by 93-638 contract funds if the Bureau of Indian  
11 Affairs has not executed and signed the contracts prior to the  
12 start of the fiscal year; and  
13 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes these programs to be beneficial and  
14 in the interest of the Papago People to operate the program with-  
15 out any break in the delivery of services.


16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby agrees to  
17 waive its position of not funding or operating any contracted  
18 program if contracts are not signed and executed by the Bureau of  
19 Indian Affairs prior to the start of the fiscal year and hereby  
20 agrees to fund the Adult and Children's Courts, and the Social  
21 Services Program, now called the Human Services Program for a  
22 period of two weeks.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 30th  
24 day of September, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
25 of 1379.0 for; 0 against; 61.0 not voting; 0 absent,  
26 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and  
27 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
28 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
29 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
30 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review  
31 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its  
32 enactment by the Papago Council.
