3	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe advised the Bureau of Indian Affairs by Resolution						
4	No. 79-83 of its intent to contract for those funds to expediate						
5	the renovation; and						
6	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe currently operates the detention and law enforce-						
	ment programs under P. L. 93-638 contracts; and						
7	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has been notified of the unsafe and unhealthy						
8	condition of the jail facility by the Environmental Health depart- ment of the Indian Health Service; and						
9	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe desires to contract for the Architectural and						
10	Engineering aspects of the renovation project in order to expedite						
	and remedy the condition of the jail.						
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize						
12	and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the						
13	Papago Tribe pursuant to the P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures						
14	for the architectural and engineering portions of the jail renovation						
15	project.						
	I) DE 11 FORTHER RESOLVED EHAE THE PAPAGO COUNCIT HELEDY LEGACS ON BUTCAU OF						
16	Indian Affairs to waive all time period requirements in view of the						
17	urgency regarding the condition of the jail and the health and safety of the prisoners, and negotiate and award a 638 contract						
18	with the Papago Tribe.						
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract will begin October 17, 1983, and						
	will terminate on November 30, 1983.						
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr.,						
21	Vice Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council is						
22	hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any						
<b>2</b> 3	amendments thereto for the duration of the contract.
