

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
A/E for Jail Renovation

RES. NO. 160-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has been advised that funds will be available
2 for the renovation of the jail under the Emergency Jobs Bill
3 signed into law by President Reagan; and
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe advised the Bureau of Indian Affairs by Resolution
5 No. 79-83 of its intent to contract for those funds to expediate
6 the renovation; and
7 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe currently operates the detention and law enforce-
8 ment programs under P. L. 93-638 contracts; and
9 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has been notified of the unsafe and unhealthy
10 condition of the jail facility by the Environmental Health depart-
11 ment of the Indian Health Service; and
12 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe desires to contract for the Architectural and
13 Engineering aspects of the renovation project in order to expedite
14 and remedy the condition of the jail.
15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize
16 and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the
17 Papago Tribe pursuant to the P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures
18 for the architectural and engineering portions of the jail renovation
19 project.
20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby requests the Bureau of
21 Indian Affairs to waive all time period requirements in view of the
22 urgency regarding the condition of the jail and the health and
23 safety of the prisoners, and negotiate and award a 638 contract
24 with the Papago Tribe.
25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract will begin October 17, 1983, and
26 will terminate on November 30, 1983.
27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr.,
28 Vice Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council is
29 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any
30 amendments thereto for the duration of the contract.
31 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
32 day of October, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
(d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
enactment by the Papago Council.
