WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised that the Skill Center has been advised that the Skill Center has been bidding on, negotiating and contracting for new construction projects at a time when it has failed to complete construction of numerous individual projects it has previously undertaken on the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Council is concerned about the Skill Center's ability to take on new projects at a time when it has a substantial backlog of work it is already in arrears on.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Skill Center is hereby directed to give priority in its construction schedule to the completion of work on outstanding projects, particularly small local or individual projects, in accordance with the original completion date committments made by the Skill Center for such projects, so as to assure fair and equal treatment to all customers of the Skill Center.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the $\frac{13th}{day}$ of October, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of $\frac{1440.0}{o}$ for; $\frac{-0-}{o}$ against; $\frac{-0-}{o}$ not voting; and $\frac{1}{o}$ absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
