

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Appointing Tribal Manager/Treasure-Trove Operations


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 134-83, authorize the
2 renegotiation and execution of an agreement for the recovery of
3 treasure-trove believed to be concealed on lands within the
4 San Xavier Reservation under the supervision and control of two
5 Tribal Managers, one a resident of the San Xavier Reservation
6 appointed by the San Xavier District Council, the other appointed
7 by the Papago Council; and

8 WHEREAS, such an agreement has been executed and it is necessary for the
9 Papago Council to designate and appoint a person to act as one
10 of the two Tribal Managers described in the agreement.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that CARMELITA MATTIAS
12 is hereby designated and appointed as one of the two Tribal
13 Managers under the agreement between the Papago Tribe and W. L.
14 Chapline, Phil Branch and C. E. Springer, as Operators, who are
15 to supervise and control all on-site physical aspects of operations
16 authorized under the agreement and to be compensated and reimbursed
17 by the Tribe at the Tribe's standard per diem and mileage rate upon
18 presentation of proper vouchers.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th
20 day of October, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) of
23 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
24 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
25 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
26 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
27 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
28 its enactment by the Papago Council.
