15	WHEREAS, The Papago council is supportive of the Papago Detox Unit and
16	believes it to be in the best interest of the Papago people; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Papago Council does hereby
17	endorse and support the goals and objectives of the Papago Detox
18	Project as a pilot program and finds its proposed scope of work
19	to be in the interests of the Papago people.

23	Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
24	Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective
2 5	as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
