RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL Authorizing Extension of Treasure-Trove Agreement

RES. NO. 191-83

WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 134-83 authorize the negotiation and extension of an agreement ("Agreement") between the Papago Tribe and certain operators, under the direction of C. E. Springer, for the recovery of treasure-trove believed to be concealed on lands within the San Xavier Reservation; and WHEREAS, the Agreement was approved by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and became effective on September 28, 1983; and WHEREAS, the Operators did use due diligence in the conduct of location and recovery operations but were unable to locate any treasuretrove within the 60-day term of the Agreement because the entry to the cave in which it purports to be has been destroyed; and WHEREAS, the Operators have offered to obtain and pay for the services

WHEREAS, it is to the advantage of both the Tribe and the Operators that the Agreement be extended in order to continue the location and recovery operations.

of geologists and other experts to help locate the site of the cave, but are unable to do so within the term of the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby authorize an extension of the Agreement upon the following terms and conditions:

- The extended term shall start January 4, 1984, and shall terminate April 1, 1984, provided that if the Operators have located treasure-trove within said extended term, said term shall continue for as long as it takes to complete recovery operations and to restore the affected lands as provided in subsection 6.1.2 of the Agreement.
- Operators shall give the Tribal Manager at least three days notice of their intention to resume on-site operations and shall conduct all on-site aspects of such operations under the immediate supervision and control of the Tribal Manager.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the day of December, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with \overline{a} vote of 1307.5 for; 79.0 against; 53.5 not voting; and 0 absent pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (e) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
