RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Authorizing Baboquivari District to  
Establish Separate Projects Accounts

RES. NO. 196-83

1 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 18, of the Papago Tribe requires that all District  
2 funds be deposited and kept in the Papago Agency Individual Indian  
3 Money (IIM) Accounts; and

4 WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council has requested authority from the  
5 Papago Council to establish and maintain a District checking  
6 account with a local bank in Tucson; and


7 WHEREAS, the District Council did by oral motion at a District meeting  
8 authorize the Baboquivari District representatives to the Papago  
9 Council to request authority for the move; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council desires a Baboquivari District Council resolution  
11 before it approves the opening of a checking account.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Baboquivari  
13 District Council will approve the transfer of District funds to a  
14 checking account with a local bank upon receipt of a District  
15 resolution reflecting this approval.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
17 day of December, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
18 of 203.0 for; 982.0 against; 255.0 not voting; and 0 absent,  
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and  
20 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review  
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its  
enactment by the Papago Council.
