

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Adoption into Papago Tribal Membership

RES. NO. 199-83

1 WHEREAS, MANUEL, Jose; GARCIA, Agnes Mary (Manuel); MANUEL, Josephine;  
2 SALAZAR, Richard L.; LEWIS, Lupe Maria (Uriarte); ANTONE, Alice  
3 (Juan); and NORIEGO, Harry J. have made application for adoption  
4 into Tribal Membership pursuant to Section 2 of Article II of  
the Constitution of the Papago Tribe; and

5 WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee has reviewed their respective applica-  
6 tions and has made a final determination that they are 1½ degree  
7 or more of Papago Indian blood, and have made a recommendation  
8 to the Papago Council that their applications be approved, all  
in accordance with the provisions with the Papago Enrollment  
Ordinance; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation of the Enroll-  
10 ment Committee and the evidence submitted in support of the  
11 individual applications.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the applications


16 are hereby approved and they are hereby adopted into membership

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th  
18 day of December, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
of 1333.0 for; 0 against; 107.0 not voting; and 0 absent,  
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 of Article  
20 II of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
21 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review  
22 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its  
enactment by the Papago Council.
