Sonoran Papagos' Representative to go with
Appropriations Delegation

RES. NO. 21-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council at the February 14, 1983, meeting, heard
2 testimony from representatives of the Sonoran Papagos concerning
3 the issues being faced by Tribal members residing in the country
4 of Mexico; and


5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council, by Resolution No. 19-83, designated a
6 Delegation of the Tribal Council to present to the United States
7 Congress programs and projects expressed as being the priorities
8 of this Tribe; and

9 WHEREAS, the issues concerning the Sonoran Papagos is a great concern of
10 the Papago Council and should be presented to the Office of the
11 Secretary of State, United States of America.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
13 authorize that a Representative of the Sonoran Papagos accompany
14 the Tribal Delegation to present issues concerning the Sonoran
15 Papagos.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th
17 day of February, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
20 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
21 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
22 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
23 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
24 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
25 enactment by the Papago Council.
