## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL Opposing Reorganization of ORD

1	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council has heard testimony concerning alternative
2		recommendations for the reorganization of the Office of Research
		and Development ("ORD") of the Indian Health Service ("IHS") in
3		Tucson in order to meet the mandate of the Senate Select Committee
4		on Indian Affairs in a Report to the Senate Budget Committee to
5		"review IHS programs, organizational structure and functions for
		effectiveness" and to "make recommendations for change to
6		accomodate a reduced budget with the least amount of disruptions
7		to employees and on the ability to delivery health services"; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council has determined that the recommendations of the
9		Special Task Force appointed by the Director of the Indian Health
		Service, and other alternative recommendations, which would
10		reorganize ORD and transfer the direct patient care, management
11		and administrative functions which it is presently providing to
12		the Papago Tribe from ORD to the Phoenix Area will cause great
		disruptions on the ability of IHS to deliver health services to
13		the Papago and Yaqui Reservations; will lead to little, if any,
14		actual financial savings; will eliminate benefits currently
15		received by both ORD and the Papago Tribe associated with the
16		direct application of ORD's research, development and other programs to a living Indian patient population; and will substan-
		tially inhibit the ability of the Papago and Yaqui Tribes to
17		negotiate alternative health delivery and financing systems with
18		local health delivery organizations and governments.
19	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe opposes any reorgani-
20	-	zation of the Office of Research and Development which would
		transfer the direct patient care, management and administrative
21		functions which it is presently providing to the Papago Tribe

24		Papago Health Services Task Force Report Position Paper as the
		official statement of the Papago Tribe on the proposed reorgan-
