

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(GU VO DISTRICT'S REDIRECTIONS)

RES. NO. 23-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 129-82, approve a
2 preliminary outline entitled Redirections which identifies
3 educational objectives to be achieved; and
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did approve and support, by Resolution No.
5 129-82, the intent of the Gu Vo District to designate all
6 interest monies earned on its IIM Account for the funding of
7 the Redirections Program; and
8 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Council did approve, by Res. No. 02-83,
9 the final draft of the Redirections Program and is seeking the
10 endorsement of the Papago Council; and
11 WHEREAS, the funding (\$19,200.00) of the Redirections Program from the
12 interest on the Gu Vo District IIM Account would amend the
13 District's amended FY 83 budget from \$127,798.00 to \$146,998.00.
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve
15 the final draft of the Redirections Program, subject to an
16 amendment eliminating any requirement of blood degree certification,
17 and does hereby further approve the amendment of the Gu Vo
18 District's amended FY 83 budget from \$127,798 to \$146,998.00
19 and authorizes expenditures in accordance therewith.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18 day of
21 February, 1983 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1089.5
22 for; 58.5 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the
23 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the
24 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as amended, ratified
25 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
26 Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
27 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approve by
28 the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary
29 of the Interior.
