

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Sif Oidak District Revenue Sharing FY 82)

RES. NO. 24-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did, by Resolution No. 54-82, appropriate
2 the sum of \$11,642.45 of FY 1982 Federal Revenue Sharing funds
3 to each of the eleven (11) Districts of the Papago Reservation,
4 to be expended by their respective District Councils in accordance
5 with the qualifying priorities expressed at the Public Hearings
conducted by the Papago Council for such purposes; and

6 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has reviewed the District
7 Communities' requests as expressed at such public hearings and
8 has allocated \$1,944.45 to each of the six District Communities
9 to be expended by them in accordance with budgets reflecting
10 the qualifying priorities expressed at the public hearings; and

11 WHEREAS, the District Communities have presented their budgets to the
12 District Council for review, which budgets were approved by the
13 District Council and are attached hereto.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the allocation
15 of FY 1982 Revenue Sharing funds to the six Communities of the
16 Sif Oidak District in accordance with the attached budgets is
17 hereby approved and that the expenditure of the funds by the
18 District Communities in accordance therewith and with the
19 qualifying priorities expressed at the public hearings conducted
20 by the Papago Council is hereby authorized.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th day
22 of February, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
23 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
24 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f)
25 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,
26 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary
27 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
28 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
29 of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
30 Council.
