WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council and District members met on February 8, 1983 to discuss the Revenue Sharing monies of 2 \$11,642.45 allocated to the District by the Papago Council; 3 4 WHEREAS, the District Council and District members discussed and reviewed the list of projects which were presented at the 5 1982 Revenue Sharing Public Hearings; and 6 WHEREAS, the decision was to spend these monies on two (2) projects 7 which were presented at the 1982 Revenue Sharing Public Hearings, as follows: 8 Two thousand one hundred forty two dollars and forty 9 five cents \$2,142.45) for purchase of tools for the District T.W.E.P. workers, and nine thousand five 10 hundred dollars (\$9,500.00) to add a snack bar including building, equipment, and kitchen appliances 11 to the District laundromat; and 12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed and approves of the District Council's decision. 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby 14 approve and authorize the expenditure of \$11,642.45 of Revenue 15 Sharing funds allocated to the Pisinemo District in accordance with the provisions of the attached Resolution of the Pisinemo 16 District Council. 17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th day 18 of February, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 abscur, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) 19 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
