

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Pisinemo District Revenue Sharing)

RES. NO. 26-83

1 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council and District members met on
2 February 8, 1983 to discuss the Revenue Sharing monies of
3 \$11,642.45 allocated to the District by the Papago Council;
4 and

4 WHEREAS, the District Council and District members discussed and
5 reviewed the list of projects which were presented at the
6 1982 Revenue Sharing Public Hearings; and

6 WHEREAS, the decision was to spend these monies on two (2) projects
7 which were presented at the 1982 Revenue Sharing Public
8 Hearings, as follows:

9 Two thousand one hundred forty two dollars and forty
10 five cents (\$2,142.45) for purchase of tools for the
11 District T.W.E.P. workers, and nine thousand five
12 hundred dollars (\$9,500.00) to add a snack bar -
13 including building, equipment, and kitchen appliances
14 to the District laundromat; and

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed and approves of the District
13 Council's decision.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
15 approve and authorize the expenditure of \$11,642.45 of Revenue
16 Sharing funds allocated to the Pisinemo District in accordance
17 with the provisions of the attached Resolution of the Pisinemo
18 District Council.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th day
19 of February, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
21 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f)
22 of Article V of the Constitution and B-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
23 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by
24 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
25 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
26 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the dates of its enactment
27 by the Papago Council.
