

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Approving budget for)
(Papago Employment Rights Commission)

RES. NO. 27-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has by Ordinance No. 1-78 established the
2 Papago Employment Rights Commission; and

3 WHEREAS, the expenses of the Commission have in the past been covered
4 by funding from the E.E.O.C. and the S.W.T.E.R.O.; and

5 WHEREAS, under Section 10 of the Ordinance an employment rights fee
6 is imposed on covered employers, payable to the Papago
7 Treasurer to cover the operating expenses of the Commission;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, there are funds available from paid funding sources and it
10 is necessary to set a budget for the Commission.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
12 hereby approve and adopt the attached budget for the Papago
13 Employment Rights Commission for FY 1983 and that the FY
14 1983 budget of the Papago Tribe be and is hereby amended
15 accordingly.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th day
17 of February, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (h) of
20 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
21 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
22 Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
23 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date
24 of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to
25 review by the Secretary of the Interior.
