WHEREAS, Muriel Segundo and Julia Carrillo were terminated by the 1 Executive Health Staff from their positions as Directors 2 of Disease Control and Nutrition Improvement, respectively; and WHEREAS, Mmes Segundo and Carrillo successfully appealed their terminations according to the Personnel Policies and Procedures 4 Manual of the Papago Tribe; and 5 WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman, in a letter to the Presonnel Officer 6 dated December 28, 1982 ordered that Officer to reinstate Mmes Segundo and Carrillo to the positions that they occupied 7 before the termination, to award them all back pay accrued 8 from the time of termination to the time of reinstatement. 9 along with any accumulated leave, and to expunge any and all evidence of their improper termination from their personnel 10 files; and 11 WHEREAS, during the pendency of Muriel Segundo's and Julia Carrillo's 12 appeals, the same individuals who improperly terminated them acted to eliminate their positions from the EHS interim budget; 13 14 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did address this matter in considering actions 15 upon Resolution No. 10-83, but the Resolution fails to express the direction of the Council; and 16 WHEREAS, the Tribal Council strongly feels that the right of these two 17 individuals to reinstatement in their former positions with 18 full back pay and the other relief ordered by the Chairman in his letter of December 28, should not be defeated because 19 of budgetary maneuvering on the part of the same people who 20 were responsible for the improper termination. 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Chairman of the Papago Tribe is hereby instructed to implement 22 the provisions of his letter dated December 28, 1982 in full. 23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th day of February, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 24 175.0 against; 224.0 not voting; and 749.0 for; absent. pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) **2**5 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, 26 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 23, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review 27 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the dates of its enactment 28 by the Papago Council
