

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Request to Recontract with IHS-Combining Alcoholism  
Prevention, Education/Rehabilitation Program Contracts

RES. NO. 30-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the following  
2 program under FY 1983 P. L. 93-638 service contracts with the  
3 Public Health, Indian Health Service:  
4 Papago Alcoholism Prevention,  
5 Education/Rehabilitation Program

6 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the  
7 Papago Tribe and its people; and

8 WHEREAS, 25 CFR, Sec. 371.20 of the Federal Regulations require that all  
9 proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the  
10 Tribal Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the  
11 contract termination; and

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council does desire to recontract for provision  
13 of these services during FY 1983.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does  
15 authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service to  
16 contract with the Papago Tribe P.L. 93-638 regulations and  
17 procedures for the provision of services titled:  
18 249-79-0010 Papago Alcoholism Prevention,  
19 Education/Rehabilitation Program

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall be from  
21 March 1, 1983, through February 28, 1984, unless extended by  
22 mutual agreement of both parties.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event that these contracts do not  
24 become effective on March 1, 1983, continuation of this program  
25 will be based on an extension of the existing 82 contracts until  
26 such time that the 83 contracts become effective.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate  
28 programs for which contracts are requested herewith which have  
29 not been negotiated and executed by the Indian Health Service  
30 prior to the start of the funding year.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence,  
32 Mr. Enos Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman or Ms. Rosita N. Ruiz,  
Treasurer, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these  
contracts and any amendments thereto for the duration of the



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract shall be subject to the reorgan-  
ization of the tribal health programs, Resolution No. 29-83.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th  
day of February, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
of 1094.0 for; 0 against; 54.0 not voting; and 1 absent,  
pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and  
(d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
