

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Approval for Use of Tribal Funds

RES. NO. 39-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 28-83, order the  
2 reinstatement of Muriel Segundo and Julie Carrillo to their  
3 respective positions as Directors of the Disease Control and  
4 Nutrition Programs; and

5 WHEREAS, funding for these programs ended after September 30, 1982, and  
6 it is necessary to establish program budgets to cover these  
7 positions for FY 1983.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
9 approve two program budgets totalling \$31,300.00 to cover the  
10 positions of Directors of the Disease Control and Nutrition  
11 Programs for FY 1983, to be funded from unexpended FY 1982  
12 tribal funds.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribe's FY 1983 budget is hereby amended  
14 to include the foregoing program budgets.

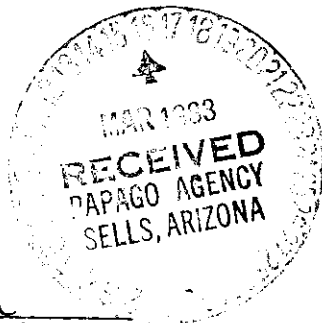
15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th  
16 day of March, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
17 1108.5 for; 0 against; 39.5 not voting; and 1 absent,  
18 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (h) of  
19 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
20 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of  
the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is  
subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
