RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL FY'82 Carryover Funds - Pre Planning/Nursing Home

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did receive a report from the Budget and Finance Committee of the FY '82 unexpended funds totalling \$193,614,00; and 2 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 20-83, allocate \$31,300. 3 of the unexpended funds; and WHEREAS, the Tribal Administration did inform the Papago Council of the 4 Tribe's eligibility to apply for funding from the Community 5 Development Block Grant Program with certain requirements, and 6 did recommend that the Tribe not apply for these funds; and 7 WHEREAS, the Papago People have expressed yearly at public hearings their request for construction of a nursing home on the Papago 8 Reservation; and 9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does accept the recommendation and that the 10 balance of unexpended FY '82 funds be used to prepare planning for the construction of a nursing home on the Papago Reservation. 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the balance of 12 FY '82 unexpended funds, \$162,314. be used to prepare the pre planning for the construction of a nursing home on the Papago 13 Reservation. 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no monies will be expended until the submission 15 and approval of a budget. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe's FY 1983 budget is hereby 16 amended accordingly. 17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18 day of March, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 998.0 for; 27.0 against; 133.0 not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
