

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
FY '82 Carryover Funds - Pre Planning/Nursing Home

RES. NO. 41-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did receive a report from the Budget and Finance  
2 Committee of the FY '82 unexpended funds totalling \$193,614.00; and  
3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 20-83, allocate \$31,300.  
4 of the unexpended funds; and  
5 WHEREAS, the Tribal Administration did inform the Papago Council of the  
6 Tribe's eligibility to apply for funding from the Community  
7 Development Block Grant Program with certain requirements, and  
8 did recommend that the Tribe not apply for these funds; and  
9 WHEREAS, the Papago People have expressed yearly at public hearings their  
10 request for construction of a nursing home on the Papago  
11 Reservation; and  
12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does accept the recommendation and that the  
13 balance of unexpended FY '82 funds be used to prepare planning  
14 for the construction of a nursing home on the Papago Reservation.  
15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the balance of  
16 FY '82 unexpended funds, \$162,314. be used to prepare the pre  
17 planning for the construction of a nursing home on the Papago  
18 Reservation.  
19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no monies will be expended until the submission  
20 and approval of a budget.  
21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe's FY 1983 budget is hereby  
22 amended accordingly.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th  
24 day of March, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
25 998.0 for; 27.0 against; 133.0 not voting; and 3 absent,  
26 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (h) of  
27 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
28 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
29 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
30 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of  
31 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is  
32 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
