

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Appointment of Children's Court Judge

RES. NO. 48-83

1 WHEREAS, the position of Judge of the Children's Court will become vacant
2 on June 10, 1983, by reason of the resignation of Judge Ned Norris
3 and it is necessary to appoint a successor; and

4 WHEREAS, the Law and Order Code provides that judges of the Papago Tribal
5 Courts be appointed by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, subject
6 to confirmation by the Papago Council; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that Malcolm Escalante is well
8 qualified to assume the position of Judge of the Children's Court.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
10 designate MALCOLM ESCALANTE as best qualified to assume the
11 position of Judge of the Children's Court; does hereby request
12 that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs appoint MALCOLM ESCALANTE
13 to such position for a period of two (2) years, effective June 10,
14 1983; and does hereby confirm such appointment.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
16 day of April, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 988.0 for; 0 against; 160.0 not voting; and 2 absent,
18 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
19 Section 3 (b) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago
20 Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12,
1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent
of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
