## DEFEATED

## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL Repealing Livestock Sales Tax

RES. NO. 52-83

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has now available to it for expenditures of 2 the tribal government the interest or investment income accruing 3 to the funds held in trust by the Secretary of Interior for the benefit of the Papago Tribe under the provisions of the Act of 4 5 January 3, 1983, P.L. 97-408, and the Papago Council believes 6 that the livestock industry on the Papago Reservation should 7 not be further burdened by the tribal tax imposed on sales of 8 livestock. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the three per 10 cent tax on livestock sales be and it is hereby repealed.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of April, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 302.0 for; 792.5 against; 53.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (h) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of

Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of its enactment by the Papago Council.
