

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Request for Income on Judgment Funds

RES. NO. 53-83

1 WHEREAS, the Act of January 3, 1983, P.L. 97-408 (96 Stat. 2035) (the "Act"),
2 providing for the use and distribution of judgment funds awarded
3 to the Papago Tribe in dockets numbered 345 and 102 of the Indian
4 Claims Commission, provides that all interest or investment income
5 accruing to the funds held in trust by the Secretary of Interior
6 ("Secretary") for the benefit of the Papago Tribe shall be available
7 at the request of the Tribe on a quarterly basis, for use by the
8 Papago Council on annual budgetary basis for expenditures of the
9 tribal government and other purposes set forth in the Act; and
10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 144-82 authorize the defer-
11 ment of \$60,000.00 in monthly payments of advance royalties due the
12 Tribe under the terms of its mining lease with Noranda Lakeshore
13 Mines, Inc. in order to permit Noranda to continue its mining
14 operations at the Lakeshore Mine, which deferment is to apply to
15 payments due the Tribe on account of advance royalties made during
16 the 1983 calendar year and is to take effect on the first day of
17 the month following receipt by the Tribe of the first payment of
18 interest or investment income accruing to the funds held in trust
19 by the Secretary for benefit of the Tribe under the Act; and
20 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 144-82 order that the
21 reductions in advance royalty payments resulting from such defer-
22 ments are to be deducted from the share of mining royalties allo-
23 cated for deposit to the general account of the Tribe under the
24 provisions of the Ordinance for the Distribution of Mining Proceeds,
25 Ordinance No. 13-82, and an amendment of the FY 1983 budget of the
26 Papago Tribe is consequently necessary to reflect the substitution
27 of funding sources; and
28 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the current budgetary requirements
29 of the Tribe; has approved the amendments of the FY 1983 budget of
30 the Papago Tribe in accordance with the attached amended budget;
31 and has determined that all of the interest or investment income
32 accruing since January 3, 1983 to the funds held in trust by the

1 Secretary for benefit of the Tribe is to be paid to the Tribe for
2 expenditures of the tribal government pursuant to the amended FY
3 1983 budget of the Papago people.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
5 approve the attached amendment of the FY 1983 budget of the
6 Papago Tribe.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request
8 the Secretary of Interior to make available to the Papago Tribe,
9 on a quarterly basis, effective immediately upon maturity of the
10 securities held by the Secretary, all of the interest or investment
11 income accruing between January 3 and September 30, 1983, to the
12 funds held in trust by the Secretary for the benefit of the Papago
13 Tribe for expenditures of the tribal government pursuant to the
14 FY 1983 budget of the Papago Tribe, as amended.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that at maturity all funds
16 held by the Secretary in trust for the benefit of the Papago Tribe
17 be invested in securities in such a manner that approximately one-
18 fourth thereof will mature each quarter, and that all interest or
19 investment income accruing thereon be credited to the Papago Tribe
20 immediately upon maturity.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
22 day of April, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
23 1094.0 for; 54.0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
24 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and
25 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
26 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
