

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Plan of Operation/Santa Rosa Boarding and Day School

RES. NO. 56-83

1 WHEREAS, under the provisions of P.L. 95-561, the governing body of Indian
2 Tribes are granted authority, or can delegate authority, to set
3 policies and to waive or revise academic standards set by the
4 Secretary of Interior for schools operated by the Bureau of
5 Indian Affairs; and

6 WHEREAS, the members of the present Board of the Santa Rosa Boarding and
7 Day School have recommended to the Papago Council a Plan of
8 Operation for the Santa Rosa Boarding and Day School Board; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the Plan of Operation and approves
10 thereof with the stipulation that the Papago Education Committee
11 has authority to set education policies for the Papago Tribe as
12 a whole.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
14 establish the Santa Rosa Boarding and Day School Board in accord-
15 ance with the provisions of the attached Plan of Operation and
16 does hereby designate said Board as the local school board for
17 the Santa Rosa Boarding and Day School.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the present members be appointed the initial
19 Board as representatives of the following Districts and for the
20 following terms:


29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Councils of the Hickiwan and

31 initial Board to fill the vacancies and for the terms shown

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
2 day of April, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
3 of 1041.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 4 absent,
4 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
5 (k) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
6 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
7 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
8 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
9 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
10 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
