

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Comprehensive Education Plan

RES. NO. 57-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council in May, 1980, approved a contract with the
2 Native American Research Associates, Inc., of Lawrence, Kansas,
3 to work with the Papago Education Department in preparing a
4 comprehensive education plan for the Papago Tribe; and

5 WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Education Plan was completed in 1981 and
6 presented on March 10, 1982, to the Papago Council; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council felt there should be additional comment
8 and review by the Papago people; and

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Department has presented the Plan to the
10 respective eleven (11) Districts of the Papago Tribe.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby
12 approve the Papago Tribe's Comprehensive Education Plan.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby direct the
14 Papago Education Department to implement the purposes of the
15 Comprehensive Education Plan.


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Education Department make periodic
17 reports, at least annually, to the Papago Council of the steps
18 taken to implement the purposes of the Comprehensive Education
19 Plan.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
21 day of April, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
22 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of
24 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
its enactment by the Papago Council.
