

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Chukut Kuk District FY 1983 Budget Amendment

RES. NO. 59-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did, by Resolution No. 125-82, approve the
2 Chukut Kuk District's FY 1983 budget to meet expenditures in
3 the amount of \$320,821.95; and

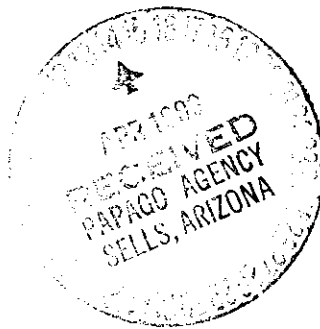
4 WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Council did approve, on March 12, 1983,
5 to amend their FY 1983 budget in the amount of \$4,000.00 for
6 the District Housing Project; and

7 WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District's IIM Account does have sufficient funds
8 to cover the amendment.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
10 approve to amend the Chukut Kuk District's FY 1983 budget from
11 \$320,821.95 to \$324,821.95 and does authorize expenditures of
12 the District's funds in accordance therewith.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
14 day of April, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
15 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
16 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and
17 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
18 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
