

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Sanctioning Spirituous Liquor in San Lucy District

RES. NO. 60-83


1 WHEREAS, Section 4 (A) of the Alcoholic Beverages Licensing and Control
2 Ordinance of the Papago Tribe, Ordinance No. 05-82, provides
3 that a District Council can by action of a majority of its
4 members sanction the introduction, sale, possession and consump-
5 tion of spirituous liquor within the exterior boundaries of the
6 District; and

7 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has by Resolution No. 26-83
8 determined that it is to the best interest of the San Lucy District
9 and its members that the introduction, sale, possession and consump-
10 tion of spirituous liquor be sanctioned in the San Lucy District.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the introduction,
12 sale, possession and consumption of spirituous liquor in accordance
13 with the provisions of the Alcoholic Beverages Licensing and
14 Control Ordinance is herewith sanctioned within the exterior
15 boundaries of the San Lucy District.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
17 day of April, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 863.5 for; 27.0 against; 257.5 not voting; and 1 absent,
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and
20 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
21 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
22 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
23 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
24 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
25 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
