

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Approving Cost of Living Bonus

RES. NO. 68-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on April 8, 1983, by enactment of Resolution
2 No. 53-83, amend the FY 1983 tribal budget to cover a 10% cost of
3 living bonus to all employees of tribally funded programs; and

4 WHEREAS, it was the intention of the Papago Council to provide such bonus
5 to employees working for tribally funded programs, as well as to
6 employees working for tribal programs funded by State or Federal
7 contracts or grants; and

8 WHEREAS, State and Federally funded programs, with few exceptions, did
9 provide for a 10% bonus or have savings in their respective 1983
10 FY budgets to cover the cost of such bonus.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
12 amend the FY 1983 budget of the Papago Tribe to provide \$27,000.
13 from the contingency reserve account of the Tribe to cover the
14 cost of providing a 10% cost of living bonus for employees in
15 the following programs:

	2. Early Childhood	83-5-1211	6,800.
17	3. Legislative Aide	83-3-1001	2,000.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it approves payment of
20 a 10% cost of living bonus based on FY 1982 earnings to all
21 tribal employees still currently employed by the Tribe who did
22 not receive cost of living/merit/salary increases subsequently to
23 those authorized by Council Resolution No. 50-80.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
25 day of May, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
26 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,
27 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) and
28 Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the
29 Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December
30 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
31 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
32 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent
of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
