

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
BIA to Select an Architectural Design Firm/Proposed High School

RES. NO. 71-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council did on April 8, 1983, authorize tribal  
2 officials to seek a P.L. 93-638 contract for architectural design  
3 services for the proposed high school; and  
4 WHEREAS, the Division of Facilities Engineering presented to the Tribe  
5 three options available for consideration; and  
6 WHEREAS, the three options were presented to the Papago Education Committee/  
7 Board of Directors on April 28, 1983, for consideration; and  
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Committee/Board of Directors after reviewing  
9 the options available voted to delegate the selection of an  
10 architectural design firm to the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and  
11 WHEREAS, the Committee requested tribal involvement at all levels regarding  
12 the approval and selection of a firm; and  
13 WHEREAS, the Committee also voted not to restrict the Bureau of Indian  
14 Affairs to the provisions of the Buy Indian Act; and  
15 WHEREAS, the Committee further decided not to restrict the geographic  
16 area for acceptance of proposals.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does authorize  
18 and delegate to the Bureau of Indian Affairs the responsibility of  
19 selecting an architectural design firm and hereby waives the  
20 restrictions imposed on the Bureau through the Buy Indian Act.


21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council authorizes the Bureau  
22 of Indian Affairs to accept any and all contract design proposals  
23 submitted from within the continental United States.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
25 day of May, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
26 982.0 for; 0 against; 166.0 not voting; and 0 absent,  
27 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) of  
28 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
29 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
30 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
31 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of  
32 the date of its enactment by the Papago Council and is not subject to review  
by the Secretary of the Interior.
