

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Hickiwan District - Liquor Violation

RES. NO. 72-83

1 WHEREAS, the introduction, sale, possession and consumption of spirituous  
2 liquor within the exterior boundaries of the Papago Reservation  
3 is in violation of the federal Indian liquor laws, 18 U.S.C.  
4 §§1154, 1156, and of the Alcoholic Beverages Licensing and  
5 Control Ordinance, Ordinance No. 05-82 of the Papago Tribe, unless  
6 it is in conformity with the Ordinance and within a District which  
7 has sanctioned the introduction, sale, possession and consumption  
8 of spirituous liquor; and


9 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District has not sanctioned the use and possession of  
10 spirituous liquor within its boundaries and a great number of  
11 violations of the laws keep occurring by bootleggers and even  
12 minors; and

13 WHEREAS, the District Council of the Hickiwan District has voiced its  
14 increasing concern about violations of liquor laws and about  
15 increased incidents of substance abuse generally, and their  
16 effect on the members and communities of the District.


17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
18 direct the Papago Police Department to give special attention to  
19 the enforcement of the liquor and substance abuse laws in the  
20 Hickiwan District and to the prosecution of violators.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th  
22 day of May, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
23 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,  
24 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) of  
25 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
26 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936. and approved by  
27 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
28 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
29 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
30 its enactment by the Papago Council.
