

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Jail Facility Renovation Contract

RES. NO. 79-83

1 WHEREAS, the Emergency Jobs Bill, P. L. 98-8, has appropriated 10 Million
2 Dollars for the renovation of BIA owned jails;

3 WHEREAS, the jail facility located in Sells is a BIA operated facility;

4 WHEREAS, the Sells jail was inspected and determined to be in need of
5 extensive renovations to meet federal compliance standards;

6 WHEREAS, the Sells facility, Papago, has been identified as one of the
7 jails to be renovated, and accordingly funds have been earmarked
8 specifically for the Papago Tribe;

9 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe recognizes the urgency and spirit in which the
10 Jobs Bill was passed and would like to begin the renovation
11 project as soon as possible.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby direct
13 the Area Director, Mr. James Stevens, to delegate hiring
14 authority to the Superintendent, Mr. Curtis C. Nordwall, to
15 hire an architect locally to begin the design of the renovated
16 jail.


17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby give notice of
18 its intent to contract for the funds appropriated for renovation
19 plus any funds allowed for A/E design fees and requests the
20 Area Director to contact the Central Office to release the
21 funds to the Papago Tribe.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1st
23 day of June, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
24 1032.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
25 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
26 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
27 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
