

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
NO Election Board Misconduct


RES. NO. 80-83

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Larry Garcia has charged the Papago Election Board with
2 misconduct by not posing the issue of "write-in" candidacy in
3 the May 28, 1983, General Election, to the Papago Council; and
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did meet on June 1, 1983, pursuant to Section
5 5 (Alternative Procedure) of Article VII, Papago Election
6 Ordinance, to hear and decide on Mr. Garcia's allegations; and
7 WHEREAS, the Tribal Secretary, by letter dated May 17, 1983, informed Mr.
8 Garcia of the meeting of the Papago Council and further informed
9 him that Section 6 (Costs and Expenses) of Article VII, states
10 it shall be determined whether the reasonable costs and expenses
11 of the contest shall be assessed against the losing party; and
12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council feels that Mr. Garcia did not provide sufficient
13 proof of misconduct on the part of the Papago Election Board.
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Mr. Larry Garcia
15 did not provide sufficient proof of misconduct on the part of the
16 Papago Election Board.
17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1st
18 day of June, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 546.5 for; 127.0 against; 358.5 not voting; and 2 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
21 (f) of Article V and Section 5 of Article III of the Constitution and By-laws
22 of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on
December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January
6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior
and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
