

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Amendment to FY'83 Housing Improvement Program

RES. NO. 82-83

1 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 76-82, the Papago Council authorized the Papago
2 Tribe to enter into a multi-year contract with the Bureau of Indian
3 Affairs pursuant to CFR 261.3 and 261.6 (c) for the Housing
4 Improvement Program; and

5 WHEREAS, the Emergency Jobs Bill, P.L. 98-8, has appropriated \$367,500.00
6 for the Housing Improvement Program; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does hereby approve that each of the eleven (11)
8 Districts of the Papago Reservation is appropriated one large house
9 and two small houses each; and


10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does hereby wish to amend the FY 1983 Housing
11 Improvement Program from \$336,200.00 to add \$367,500.00, totalling
12 \$703,700.00 for FY 1983.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
14 appropriate one large house and two small houses to each of the
15 eleven (11) Districts of the Papago Reservation.


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby wish to amend
17 the FY 1983 Housing Improvement Program budget from \$336,200.00
18 to \$703,700.00 pursuant to the Emergency Jobs Bill, P.L. 98-8.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 2nd
20 day of June, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 1060.5 for; 87.5 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of
23 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
24 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
25 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
26 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
27 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
28 its enactment by the Papago Council.
