

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Gu Vo District Budget Amendment FY '83

RES. NO. 92-83

1 WHEREAS, the District Council of the Gu Vo District did by Resolution No.  
2 05-83, appropriate the sum of \$23,172.00 to fund the District's  
3 Summer Youth Program, and did amend its FY 1983 District budget  
4 accordingly; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the attached budget for the Gu  
6 Vo District Summer Youth Program in the sum of \$23,172.00 and  
7 approves thereof, and has determined that there are sufficient  
8 funds in the District's IIM Account to cover such budget.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
10 approve amendment of the FY 1983 budget of the Gu Vo District  
11 to cover the District's Summer Youth Program and does hereby  
12 authorize the expenditure of funds in accordance with the  
13 attached budget.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th  
15 day of June, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
16 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,  
17 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and  
18 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
19 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
20 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
21 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
22 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago  
23 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
