

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Authorizing Opening Of and Withdrawals from Bank Accounts

RES. NO. 94-83

1 WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe, the
2 Treasurer of the Papago Council is charged with the acceptance,
3 receipt and safekeeping of all tribal funds, and with the
4 deposit of such funds as directed by the Papago Council.


5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Treasurer
6 of the Papago Council, with the approval of the Chairman, is
7 hereby authorized to open and maintain such checking, savings
8 or other banking accounts in the name and on behalf of the
9 Papago Tribe.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, until further order of this Council, any
11 funds of the Papago Tribe deposited in such accounts be subject
12 to withdrawal or charge at any time upon checks, notes, drafts,
13 bills of exchange, acceptances, undertakings or other instru-
14 ments or orders for the payment when made, signed, drawn,
15 accepted, or endorsed on behalf of the Papago Tribe by any two
16 of the following officers of the Papago Council, namely, the
17 Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary and Administrative
18 Assistant.


19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary or any other officer of the
20 Papago Council from time to time in office is authorized to
21 verify the names of the officers of the Papago Council and their
22 respective offices, together with specimens of their signatures,
23 and in case of any change of any holder or holders of any such
24 office or offices, the fact of such change and the names of any
25 new officers and the offices respectively held by them, together
26 with specimens of their signatures.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
28 day of June, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
29 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,
30 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
31 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
32 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
