

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Housing Improvement Program  
"Jobs Bill"

RES. NO. 96-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Government established the Papago Skill Center  
2 by Resolution No. 04-79, and the O'odham Construction by Resolution  
3 No. 58-80, both are 100% tribally owned and operated; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Skill Center has trained 75 Papagos in construction  
5 trades since the Skill Center opened in August, 1981, and proposed  
6 to place its construction trades graduates with the O'odham  
7 Construction; and

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Skill Center has constructed four (4) model homes with  
9 the floor plans and construction techniques that are acceptable to  
10 the Union and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

11 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has made available to the Papago Tribe  
12 through the Jobs Bill, HIP Housing Funds in the amount of \$637,500.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize  
14 the Papago Tribe to enter into a one year contract with the Bureau  
15 of Indian Affairs pursuant to 25 CFR 271.12 and 271.14 for the  
16 Housing Improvement Program (HIP). The contract terms will be  
17 July 11, 1983, through July 10, 1984.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the eligibility criteria will be as follows:  
19 each District shall select three (3) participants and three (3)  
20 alternates pursuant to 25 CFR 256.5 eligibility.


21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr.,  
22 Vice Chairman and Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council  
23 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and  
24 any amendments thereto on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

25 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 24th  
26 day of June, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
27 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,  
28 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (e)  
29 and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
30 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
31 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
32 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
