

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Range Management

RES. NO. 97-83

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Papago Agency, has received  
2 agriculture funds for Range Management from the Jobs Bill in the  
3 amount of \$357,850.00; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has reviewed and accepted a tribal plan  
5 to employ thirty-three (33) District members for one (1) year for  
6 District range management projects.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize  
8 the Papago Tribe to enter into a one (1) year P.L. 93-638 contract  
9 with the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to 25 CFR 271.12 and  
10 271.14 for Range Management. The contract term will be July 11,  
11 1983, through July 10, 1984.


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Jr.,  
13 Vice Chairman and Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council  
14 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and  
15 any amendments thereto on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 24th  
17 day of June, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
18 1237.0 for; 203.0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,  
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (e)  
20 and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
21 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
