

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Community Development Block Grant - Jobs Bill

RES. NO. 99-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has an obligation for the welfare of its  
2 members and may authorize specific projects/programs to  
3 meet its obligation; and

4 WHEREAS, the U. S. Congress did by enactment of the Emergency Jobs  
5 Bill provide appropriations for labor intensive employment  
6 for hundreds of jobless Americans, and, did earmark specific  
7 amounts for Indians on Indian Reservations; and

8 WHEREAS, in addition to the "Indian" appropriations, Tribes are also  
9 eligible for Jobs Bill funds in other categories such as the  
10 Community Development Block Grants; and

11 WHEREAS, the primary objective of the CDBG Jobs Bill funds is to  
12 provide labor intensive public service activities; and

13 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe wishes to provide immediate employment by  
14 carrying out a reservation-wide clean-up campaign in  
15 cooperation with the Indian Health Service; and

16 WHEREAS, this proposed activity is an eligible category under the  
17 Community Development Block Grant.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council does hereby  
19 authorize the Executive Office to seek funds under the Community  
20 Development Block Grant - Jobs Bill for the proposal attached  
21 herein.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th  
23 day of July, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
24 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,  
25 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and  
26 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
27 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review  
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its  
enactment by the Papago Council.
