


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Pisinemo District's Budget Amendment FY '85)


1 WHEREAS, The Pisinemo District Council did by Resolution No. 7-84 approve the
2 expansion of the San Simon Village Church using District funds; and
3 WHEREAS, The construction project will be contracted and bidded out to a suc-
4 cussful bidder; and
5 WHEREAS, The total project cost for the construction is \$7,174.32 and the
6 District Council does have sufficient funds in its IIM Account to
7 cover the costs;
8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Papago Council that it does approve the
9 Pisinemo District Council's request and hereby authorize the amendment
10 of the FY-85 budget of \$161,937.42 to reflect an increase of \$7,174.32
11 bringing the revised budget to \$169,111.74 and further authorizes
12 expenditures in accordance therewith.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 09th
14 day of January, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
15 of 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent; pursuant
16 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of
17 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, rati-
18 fied by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its
approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review
by the Secretary of the Interior.


