

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Adoption into Tribal Membership)

RES. NO. 08-85

1 WHEREAS, SEGUNDO, Phillip J.; GARCIA, Frank; FOUTZ, Kurt; MENDEZ, Macedonio R;
2 MENDOZA, Minnie (Salcido); have made application for adoption into
3 Tribal membership pursuant to Section 2 of Article II of the Consti-
4 tution of the Papago Tribe; and

5 WHEREAS, The Enrollment Committee has reviewed their respective applications,
6 has made a final determination that they are 1-1/2 degree or more of
7 Papago Indian blood, and have made a recommendation to the Papago
8 Council that their applications be approved, all in accordance with
9 the provisions with the Papago Enrollment Ordinance; and

10 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has reviewed the recommendation of the Enrollment
11 Committee and the evidence submitted in support of the individual
12 applications.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the applications for

18 are hereby approved and they are hereby adopted into membership of the
19 Papago Tribe.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 09th
21 day of January, 1985, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
22 of 1,440.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant
23 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 of Article II of
24 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
25 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
26 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
27 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
28 the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
29 Council.
